CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

BY ENTERING MACQUARIE UNIVERSITY SPORT AND AQUATIC CENTRE (MUSAC) YOU AGREE TO ADHERE TO OUR COVIDSAFE CONDITIONS OF ENTRY. WE ASK THAT YOU:

- Do not attend MUSAC if you are feeling unwell.
- All members and visitors MUST show your proof of vaccination or your medical exemption to staff each time you attend the centre. Entry will be refused if you do not show proof of vaccination or medical exemption.
- All members and visitors MUST scan in via the Service NSW QR Code prior to entering MUSAC. Entry will be refused if you do not demonstrate a successful Service NSW QR Code sign in process.
- Members must produce your membership card upon entry and scan on exit to enable the recording of accurate attendance records.
- Face masks must be worn by all members and visitors in indoor areas, unless exempt or engaging in strenuous physical exercise.
- There is a strict "no towel, no train" policy. Entry to the Health Club will be refused if you do not have a towel.
- You must thoroughly wipe down all equipment before and after use, using the sanitising wipes provided.
- Bring your own mat when attending Group Exercise classes.
- Water is available via our vending machines and Crunch Café only.
- Changerooms remain open, however we ask that you practice good hand hygiene etiquette and maintain 1.5m physical distancing.
- Please take personal responsibility for social distancing by adhering to dedicated floor markings, avoid congregating prior to the start of group exercise classes and group bookings, respect capacity rules and only use the equipment and space that is available.
- Please be respectful to staff whose job it is to enforce COVIDSafe procedures.
